We would appreciate if you could model cursive writing with your child e.g. encourage child to write name using cursive writing (Please see attached cursive letter formation sheet.)

# Maths

This week in maths we were looking at patterns. We looked at patterns by colour, shape and size. We created patterns using 2 different colours/2 different shapes & a mixture of 2 colour/shapes, we created patterns using 3 different colours/3 different shapes & a mixture of 3 colours/shapes. We made patterns on table and on laces. We had to explain our pattern to the boys and girls in our group.
