# Maths

We are continuing our counting activities and games. We are focusing on number order between I and 5. We are also working with the blank number line. The teacher calls out a number and you have to point to where it should be on the number line. We are also looking at before and after. E.g. What number is BEFORE 4?(Answer 3). What number is AFTER 1? (Answer 2). We are playing the number games 'Fill the Sweetie Jar', 'Number Bears,' 'Animal Hunt' and 'Snail Trail' We are continuing to develop our understanding of money. Focusing on Ic, 2c and 5c coins we are sorting the coins, ensuring we understand the

value of coins and purchasing items using the coins.

# Learn Together: Easter

This week in school we have been learning all about the Christian Festival Easter. We have the Story of Easter on our Noticeboard. We picked our favourite parts of the story and wrote about them and drew pictures.

Here is the story of Easter: Jesus travelled on dankey to Jerusalem. Lots of people came out to the streets to greet him and waved palm leaves at him. Some people were jealous of Jesus and did not want him to be there. He had a big dinner with his friends called the Last Supper. However Jesus was sad because he knew he was going to be betrayed. After dinner he went to the Garden of Gethsemane and prayed. The next day Jesus' enemies came to get him. They put him an the cross and he died. He was put in a tomb. Two days later the tomb was empty. Jesus was alive again.

Next week we will be looking at the Passover.

- Passaver or Pesach as it is sometimes called is a Jewish festival celebrated in Spring time.
- The main part of the Passover celebration is the meal. This is called the **Seder**. The special order of the Seder meal is written down in the **Hagadah**, this tells the story of the Exadus.
- The celebration is called 'pass over' because it reminds the Jews of the last of the ten plagues, when the angel of death passed over the Jews and killed the Egyptians first born

We will also read the story about the Easter Bunny. We will have an Easter Egg Hunt and we will create some yummy Easter surprises.

# Gardening Club

We are making great progress with our Gardening Club. We now have 3 raised flower beds. Thanks to Behrad and Vanipriya for donating compost!
