## Pipalong @Powerstown Educate Together

Pipalong @ Powerstown ETNS are opening an afterschool service for children aged between 4 and 12 years of age, from September 2012. We operate on a 50 week year in line with the school Calendar and School Holidays. We provide the following services in our Powerstown Facility:

- **Full-Time Care**

Full time care applies to children who will attend Pipalong from Monday to Friday 1:10 until 6:00 pm.

- **Hour Club**

This option is run for Junior and Senior Infant children. These children are provided with the option to stay on at school for an extra hour. This will accommodate parents with children in older classes with one pick up time rather than collecting one child at 1:10pm and then having to return again at 2:10pm.

- **Homework Club**

The Homework Club is run for all students attending Pipalong from Monday to Thursday. This program runs from 2:10– 3:10m daily and provides children with an hour of tutored homework time.

- **Part-time care**

We cater of any of the above options on a part-time basis.

### **Rates of Service**

Full time care €450 a Month

Full time care when school is closed and care is required from 9am until 6pm will be an extra €50 a week

Hour Club and Homework club €6 per Hour

Part-time care is charged pro rata
