Simustaneous Oral Spelling

(Orton, Gillingham & Stillman 1956; Bradley 1981)

- Thisd chooses word to be searned
- The word is written for the child
- Thild reads the word
- Thild writes the word, saying the letter names as s/he writes
- Thisd checks the attempt
- Word is revised over a period of six days
- Child is led to generalise from this to other words, using plastic letters
