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Fancy Dress Fundraiser on 23/10/2020

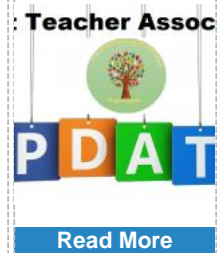

Below is a letter from the DES which includes, among other information, statistics on Covid-19 transmission in the schools' context. I hope that it may provide some reassurance to our school community

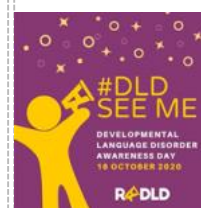
