Tyrrelstown Cup 2022!

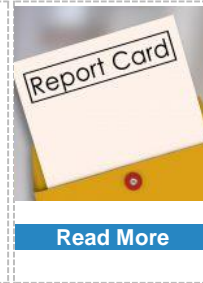

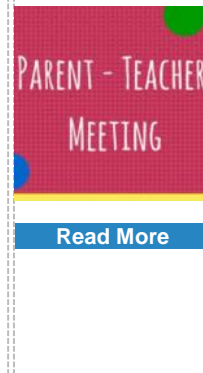
Report Cards
