LOGICAL CONSEQUENCES

Logical conseqences are consequences for actions that are reasonable, respectful and related to the action. They may be natural or implemented by a member of staff




Consequences should be balanced with the misbehaviour

LOGICAL CONSEQUENCES Logical consequences are consequences for actions that are reasonable, respectful and related to the action. They may be natural or implemented by a member of staff

THREE R's

- 1. **Reasonable:** Consequences should be balanced with the presenting behaviour 2. **Respectful:** It is important for the staff member to use a respectful tone of voice when delivering a consequence
- 3. Related: Consequences should be directly connected to the action

EXAMPLES

• A student uses their phone during school, so a staff member confiscates the phone • A student plays rough on yard and injures a peer, so a staff member asks that student to stand aside on

• A student repeatedly forgets to bring in their homework, so the teacher asks child to catch up during free time / lunch
